ISR COLLABORATION WITH WHO ON RAPID ADVICE GUIDE FOR COVID-19

The WHO is developing a Rapid Advice Guideline on the use of imaging in COVID-19 patients with the aim to support countries in their response to the pandemic regarding the use radiation in health facilities. The Guideline Development Group (GDG) is chaired by G. Frija and includes numerous experts from all over the world proposed by the ISR. ISR Communications Working Group member Ivana Blazic, who collaborated with WHO on updating the WHO webpages related to imaging, acts as ISR expert and rapporteur in this endeavour. The core group is working at full speed and interacting on a daily basis to develop the guide as quickly as possible during the month of April.

To provide additional material for the review of the literature considered for the guidelines, the ISR, in collaboration with the European Society of Radiology (ESR) has performed a survey of selected hospitals across the globe to gain insights into how medical imaging is used in the management of COVID-19 and to what extent the novel disease impacts the radiology department's routine work.
